We consistently prove the effectiveness of our project planning and management system through successful project execution. GIS has performed as both a general and sub-contractor in upstream, midstream, and downstream environments, providing a wide array of self-performed services, and working alongside other contractors from many diverse disciplines.



### **Shell MARS Platform Recovery**

The Shell MARS Platform was significantly damaged by Hurricane Katrina's 170 mph sustained winds and eighty-foot waves. GIS provided 360 personnel, produced all ISO drawings, designed all work packages, managed all Intelligent Connected Piping. GIS managed its own crews as well as the crews of two other companies, and provided all necessary tools and equipment. With this project, GIS was not only able to help return the largest producing platform in the Gulf of Mexico back to service, but did so ahead of schedule.



### **Chevron Mabee Project**

GIS installed NGL Recovery Equipment at the Chevron Mabee CO<sub>2</sub> Compression Facility in Midland, TX, with all construction taking place inside an existing operating plant. In addition to being the single qualified contractor for all three phases of work, GIS self-performed all civil work, piping connections, setting of equipment skids, electrical & instrumentation, as well as start-up and commissioning.



### Kinder Morgan Compression Stations 9, 110, 301, & 302

GIS provided turn-key construction services at four compression stations in the Utica & Marcellus Shale Regions of Kentucky, Pennsylvania, and Ohio. These projects illustrate GIS's ability to simultaneously perform multiple capital projects of varying size, scope, and conditions, while maintaining the quality and safety standards that our customers have grown to expect.



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
